



The Division of Health Facility Survey and Field Operations conducts inspections of more than 2,200 long-term care facilities, acute care facilities, medical day care, and other healthcare facilities statewide. Oversight is required to ascertain compliance with regulations, assess minimum quality and safety standards, and assess access to healthcare for all citizens. Professional surveyors conduct routine surveys and complaint investigations to assess for compliance with applicable state and federal regulations, require the implementation of corrective action plans, and recommend enforcement as indicated.

Health Care Services Evaluator/Nurse

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience as a professional Registered Nurse; which shall have included one or more of the following: clinical nursing, practice in nursing supervision, nursing management, or public health nursing; or three (3) years of experience in the evaluating or rating of licensed and/or certified health care facilities or managed health care plans to determine compliance with state licensure and Medicare and Medicaid standards.

NOTE: Applicants who have graduated from an accredited school of nursing or possess an Associates Degree in Nursing may substitute two (2) years of additional experience on a year-for-year basis for the required Bachelor's degree.

NOTE: Appointees will be required to successfully complete the Basic Surveyor Training and pass the Surveyor Minimum Qualifying Test. The training will be provided at the onset of employment.

LICENSES: Applicants must possess a current license as a professional Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey and will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

Public Health Consultant 2 Nutrition

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree supplemented by a Master's degree in any nutrition specialty such as Public Health Nutrition, Human Nutrition, Dietetics, Food Service Administration, or Nutrition Education.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience in nutrition or dietetics, one (1) year of which must have been as a nutritionist in an administrative or consultant capacity.

NOTE: Completion of an approved dietetic internship in hospital dietetics, clinical nutrition, administration, or public health may be substituted for one (1) year of required experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Field Representative Pharmaceuticals 1

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree in Pharmacy.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience as either a Registered Pharmacist in a hospital pharmacy or retail pharmacy, a staff pharmacist in a health care facility, or as a pharmacist surveyor for state or federal survey agency or equivalent.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Public Health or Pharmacology, may be substituted for one (1) year of the required experience.

LICENSES: Appointees must possess a valid license as a Registered Pharmacist issued by the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy and will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.
